1. Compare the positive and negative effects of isolation and solitude on the protagonists of Tracks and Charlie's Country.
2. Compare how Tracks and Charlie's Country explore their characters' sense of being an outsider to Australian society.
3. Compare how the challenges and benefits of relationships and community are experienced by characters in Tracks and Charlie's Country.
4. Compare how personal growth and change are experienced by Charlie and Robyn.
5. Compare how Tracks and Charlie's Country explore the importance of the natural world.
6. "Hunting is not recreational. It's for food!" (*Charlie's Country*)  
"There is nothing so real as having to think about survival".

Compare how the characters in *Tracks* and *Charlie's Country* are driven by the need to survive.
