- 1. Compare the positive and negative effects of isolation and solitude on the protagonists of <u>Tracks</u> and <u>Charlie's Country</u>.
- 2. Compare how <u>Tracks</u> and <u>Charlie's Country</u> explore their characters' sense of being an outsider to Australian society.
- 3. Compare how the challenges and benefits of relationships and community are experienced by characters in <u>Tracks</u> and <u>Charlie's Country.</u>
- 4. Compare how personal growth and change are experienced by Charlie and Robyn.
- 5. Compare how <u>Tracks</u> and <u>Charlie's Country</u> explore the importance of the natural world.
- 6. "Hunting is not recreational. It's for food!" (*Charlie's Country*) "There is nothing so real as having to think about survival".

Compare how the characters in *Tracks* and *Charlie's Country* are driven by the need to survive.
